






Centuries-old and super-centuries-old olives that can withstand the wind and time, especially greens such as "harmless", "wild leek", "wild artichoke" and "Artikites" mushrooms, mushrooms that always grow at the root of the plant that is very common in Crete "Arkitas", wild partridges and impressive lammergeyer (Gypaetus barbatus), that make their appearance frequently, compose a landscape of rare flora and fauna.






















This is land that used to be the only livelihood for the inhabitants of the wider area. Old threshing floors, dry stones (masonry technique of ancient times, without cohesive mortar between the stones).





The art of dry stone is now on the UNESCO list for the intangible cultural heritage of mankind. Small agricultural buildings, stone plinths (makeshift structures for the protection of domestic animals), sochora (fenced fields), unfold before the eyes of the visitor, revealing a valuable agricultural cultural heritage.
